All dogs competing in must be at least 9 months of age.

Entries For Exhibition Only will not be accepted.

Alternates List: Entries received after the numerical limits have been reached but prior to closing will be placed on an alternates list. If you DO NOT wish to be on the alternates list, please enclose a signed statement to that effect with your entry. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies

in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.

Per Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Herding Regulations, "In tests and for move-ups from a test class to a trial class, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial classes, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.

Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier class (provided the alternate's class has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same Judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's class."

Entry fees will be refunded for alternates whose dogs do not run.

Bitches in season are permitted to run. They will be placed at the end of the running order in test classes and run in catalog order in trial classes.

Special Awards

The **Boone Memorial Trophy** is awarded to the Bearded Collie Dog with the highest combined score on sheep, using qualifying scores from A, B, or C course or any combination of these courses. The trophy, offered by Ann Witte, in memory of Am/Can CH Artisan Bronze Paladin HXAs, is a small replica of a bronze sculpture of a Bearded Collie facing off a Scottish Blackface ram mounted on a wooden base.

The **Ann Adler Witte Memorial Trophy** is presented to the highest scoring veteran Bearded Collie on any stock/course at each year's National specialty herding event(s). The trophy, offered by the Great Plains Bearded Collie Club, is a replica of a ram's horn with a Bearded Collie and Scottish thistle engraved in silver on the horn.

The **Owd Bob Award** is presented to the highest scoring owner-handled Bearded Collie, any level/class/stock at each year's BCCA National Specialty herding trial(s). The trophy, offered by an anonymous group of Bearded Collie owners, shows a bas-relief sculpture of a handler and a seated Bearded Collie. Each bears an inscription engraved on a brass plate. A second brass plate provides space for the owner to engrave the name of the dog. A tie would be broken, first in favor of the higher level (any stock, any course) and second, if needed, by the combination of all qualifying scores (any stock, any level, any course) during the specialty trial(s).

Email will be used as a primary means of communication if an email address is listed on the entry form unless entrant requests otherwise.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Incomplete or unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

All entry fees payable in US funds. Entries without full fees will not be accepted.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in the exhibitor's entries being accepted on a CASH ONLY basis.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in case of any such errors after the closing date.

Declination of entries: BCCA may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have recourse against BCCA, any official thereof, or any judge

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any trial.

A medication fee of \$50, the Veterinarian's bill, or the cost of the animal will be charged to the owner of any dog causing damage to livestock, whether such damage is caused directly or indirectly by the dog. Please read the agreement on the back of the entry form.

When not competing, dogs must be confined or held on leash and kept away from the livestock.

The Bearded Collie Club of America and the owners of Black Birch Farm South & the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or spectators, or by any of their dogs or property.

Children must be kept under the control of their parents or guardians at all times and must be kept away from all farm equipment and livestock.

No unauthorized persons or dogs allowed in barn or house.

Wading pools will be available for your dogs.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the organizing committee, it is impossible to open or complete the test/trial, no refund of entry will be made. Extreme weather conditions, including, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning or extreme temperatures, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, livestock, exhibitors, judges and spectators. The well being of dogs, livestock, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the test/trial before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

No refunds will be given for overpayment of fees if the error is less than \$10.00.

PLEASE NOTE: NO SMOKING ON THE GROUNDS AT ANY TIME , NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED

TRIAL SITE INFORMATION: Will be open from 7:30 am til 1/2 hour after the completion of the event. Dogs may not be left overnight. Please bring shade cloths & chairs. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request. Please assure that your dogs are free from communicable disease & parasite. All dogs must be held on leash, except during tests or trials. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test/trial area & not allowed to harass resting livestock. Handlers should bring water & provide shade for their dogs. **Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs and dispose of the waste in appropriate receptacles.**

NO VIDEOING ON SITE unless express permission has been given by the person being videoed and is for their private use only

NO SMOKING ON PROPERTY. If you insist on smoking, pick up your butts!
